Computer Access Agreement

At Cawarral we value the role of computers in learning and aim to ensure that all students have fair and equitable access to technology. With this access comes responsibilities, which include:

- Not altering the desktop, systems folders or other components of the operating system
- Not installing software unless directly instructed by the teacher
- Only using the computer when permission has been granted by the teacher
- Not inserting any personal disks to avoid the transmission of computer viruses
- Keeping food and drinks away from the computer and ensuring clean hands before using the computer
- Not tampering with the hardware eg. Printer, cables etc.
- Reporting any unusual or inappropriate computer use to the teacher immediately.

The Internet is a valuable tool, which can be used to promote learning outcomes across key learning areas. However, due to its complexity and the risks which can be associated with working on-line, it is crucial that students and parents read the following and sign before any access is permitted. Students will only use the Internet at Cawarral in guided situations for specific purposes.

Internet Access Agreement

I understand that the Internet can connect me to much useful information stored on computers around the world.

While I have access to the Internet: I will use it only for educational purposes I will not look for anything that is illegal, dangerous or offensive.

If I accidentally come across something that is illegal, dangerous or offensive, I will:

- a) Clear any offensive pictures or information from my screen; and
- b) Immediately, quietly, inform my teacher.

I will not reveal home addresses or home numbers - mine or anyone else's.

I will not use the Internet to annoy or offend anyone else.

I understand that if the school decides I have broken these rules, appropriate action will be taken. This may include loss of my Internet access for some time.
